Speaker: Prof. QingQuan LIU

Liu Qingquan, professor, chief physician, doctoral supervisor, president of Beijing Hospital of Traditional Chinese Medicine affiliated to Capital Medical University, director of Beijing Institute of Traditional Chinese Medicine. He has been awarded a number of personal honorary titles by the Ministry of Education, the State Administration of Traditional Chinese Medicine, and the Beijing Municipal Government, including "Changjiang Scholar" and "Qihuang Scholar". Concurrently serves as the chairman of the State Administration of Traditional Chinese Medicine's Emergency Key Specialty Collaboration Group, the chairman of the Emergency Branch of the Chinese Association of Traditional Chinese Medicine, the chairman of the Standardized Training and Assessment Branch of the Chinese Association of Traditional Chinese Medicine, the vice president of the China Association of Integrative Traditional Chinese and Western Medicine, and the Beijing Municipal Integrative Medicine of Traditional Chinese and Western Medicine Society president and other duties. Has undertaken a number of national and provincial scientific research projects. In the past five years, he has published more than 200 academic papers, including more than 40 SCI papers. In 2020, he will be the first overseas downloaded scholar. He has won many scientific and technological awards such as the "First Prize of Beijing Science and Technology Award". Won the titles of "Advanced Individual in the Prevention and Control of the New Coronary Pneumonia Epidemic in the National Health System" and "National Advanced Individual in TCM Emergency Response".

Cheng Haiying, a nationally renowned senior traditional Chinese medicine practitioner, the first honoured TCM practitioner in Beijing. She is professor, and representative inheritor of Professor He Puren, the first National Master of Chinese medicine. Cheng Haiying is an internationally invited expert for training by the World Federation of Chinese Medicine Societies. She holds positions as the Executive Vice President of the Beijing Acupuncture Association, Director of the Needle Technique Professional Committee, Vice President of the Beijing San Tong Fa Research Society, and an outstanding inheritor of the Professor He's Fire Needle Technique. Cheng Haiying has published several works, including "Practical Manual of Acupuncture Clinical Practice," "Course Outline of Cheng Haiying's Acupuncture Studies," "Inheritance and Insight of National Medicine," "Practical Manual of Human Meridians and Acupoints," "New Edition of Practical Manual of Acupuncture Clinical Practice," and "Insights into Acupuncture Clinical Practice." She excels in utilizing various acupuncture techniques to treat intractable conditions, particularly making significant breakthroughs in post-craniotomy nerve injuries, nerve injuries after tumor chemotherapy, chronic progressive pulmonary diseases, and motor neuron injuries. He has developed unique treatment methods and accumulated abundant clinical experience.

Lily Lai PhD., is a highly experienced acupuncturist and Chinese herbal medicine practitioner with over 18 years' of clinical experience. She was the first practitioner in the UK to have her PhD fellowship sponsored by the National Institute for Health Research (NIHR). She carried out her PhD at the University of Southampton with Professor George Lewith on the topic of Chinese herbal medicine in primary care specifically for regulating periods in polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS). She has presented over 50 research reports at medical, academic and patient conferences both nationally and internationally, and has published over 40 research articles in peer-reviewed journals. She runs a busy private practice in Manchester UK working collaboratively with other medical professionals, and specialises in women's health, chronic pain and inflammatory conditions. Alongside her clinical work, she continues to supervise and mentor doctoral students and early careers practitioners and teaches undergraduate and postgraduate students on acupuncture, Chinese herbal medicine and research methods.

JiDong WU, qualified as a TCM practitioner in Nanjing medical school in 1977 and then practiced TCM in a general hospital in Nanjing for four years. He then entered Shanghai University of TCM for postgraduate programme and was awarded master's degree in medicine in 1986. He came to UK in 1993 as visiting scholar exchange programme. In 1997 he worked at the Middlesex University, where he set up the first undergraduate degree programme of TCM, as a senior lecture. He was the president of the ATCM during 2002-2006. Currently practices in Cambridge. He is the president of the European FSN Association with FSN Level three qualification.

HuiAn LIU, graduated from Tianjin TCM University in 1985 with a bachelor's degree in Acupuncture, then he worked at the TCM University affiliated hospital afterwards as deputy chief physician and deputy minister of Acupuncture & Moxibustion. In 2016, she began studying abdominal acupuncture and were accepted as a disciple by Professor Bo ZhiYun, the inventor and founder of abdominal acupuncture. Currently, she applies abdominal acupuncture in clinical practice with significant therapeutic effects for joint pain, obstetrics and gynaecology diseases as well as other difficult-to-treat conditions.
